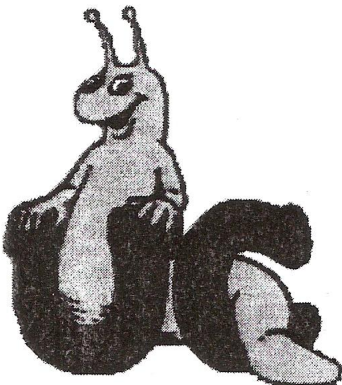

Requirements



A

History/Social Sciences 2 years required

1 year of US History and 1/2 year of Civics or American Government.

1 year of World History, Cultures, and Geography.

B

English 4 years required

There is a difference between English and College Prep English. Classes should include frequent writing and reading of classic and modern literature.

C

Mathematics 3 years required, 4 recommended

Beginning with Algebra 1.

Approved Integrated Math (IMP) courses may be used to fulfill part or all of this requirement.

D

Lab Science 2 years required, 3 recommended

1 year must be a Life Science. (ex. Biology, Physiology)

1 year must be a Physical Science.(ex. Chemistry, Physics)

No more than 1 year of 9th grade lab science can be used for this requirement.

E

Language other than English

2 years required, 3 recommended

2 years must be taken in the same language.

Courses should emphasize grammar, vocabulary, reading, and composition.

F

Visual/Performing Art 1 year required

1 year of a Visual or Performing art is required.
(ex. Advanced Art, Photo, Dance, Drama)

G

College Preparatory Elective 1 year required

Advanced Courses from the following areas:

- History - Social Science - English
- Advanced Math - 3rd year foreign language
